Exactly these qualifications, their extended language competence and the intercultural experiences are going to give the graduates of the European master's program MEDes better job opportunities within the international market. This program is carried out in cooperation with partner universities at Milan, Stockholm, Helsinki, Paris and Glasgow. We are also planning further post-graduate programs such as a Ph.D. in Design together with the University of Western Sydney.</p>
